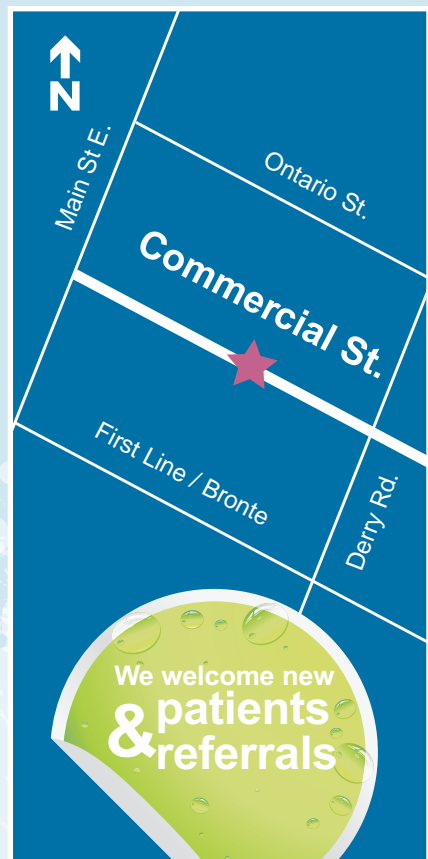
CAD-CAM Precision Dental Implants

Combining a computed tomography (CT) Scan and "computer aided design/computer aided manufacturing" CAD/CAM technology, we can determine the ideal position, length/width and angulations of your dental implant so that the edges of the crown lie just under the edges of the gumline. In many cases we can use zirconia, an extremely strong ceramic material, that will not show darkness through the gum tissue making your new permanent tooth look, feel, and function like a natural tooth.

Dental implants are changing the way people live! With dental implants, people are rediscovering the comfort and confidence to eat, speak, laugh, and enjoy life. The implants themselves are tiny artificial titanium roots that are placed into the site(s) where teeth are missing. The bone bonds with the titanium, creating a strong foundation for artificial teeth. Implants can also be used to stabilize loose-fitting dentures.
